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MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES (CONTINUED)

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On August 23, a portion of N. Overbrook Road washed away caused by a deluge of rain from Henri storm which created an emergency condition. The Supervisors met on that basis and filed an Emergency Declaration Resolution. They contacted MHW, Roadmaster Van Fleet and Engineer John Seamans and proceeded to repair the washout.

Roadmaster Bruce Van Fleet checked the area on 9/1 and all appeared satisfactory. On 9/3 sluice pipe work was done on College Road. He supervised N. Overbrook project and College Road work and cut brush on N. Turnpike. UGI will replace service and will send a check first. He spoke to Mrs. Kondash who wants a road sign at the bottom of the road intersecting w/ Rt. 6/11 which leads to her house under construction. Secretary will obtain companies who supply signs and the Board will decide if Mrs. Kondash will be under obligation to purchase the sign as well and if the Township will install it.

Engineer John Seamans reported N. Overbrook Road project is completed but water is coming from Rt. 6/11 and Tall Timbers. Penn DOT should be consulted. He also has information for a legal ad for Maple Road work regarding tree removal, ditch work etc. He will mark trees to be removed and will send specifications to the Secretary for this project.

Motion was then made by Henry, seconded by Wohlken to proceed with Comcast and installation necessary to have a computer installed at the Township Building with laptops and any other necessary equipment. John Moros will process the order.

Secretary will contact Penn DOT to see if anything can be done regarding Latin American Car lot with cars so close to the highway resident in the house next door can't get mail delivered.

Snow Removal legal ad will be placed on 9/13 and specifications completed for bidders.

October 21 will be Budget Preparation, starting at 5:00 pm.

Motion was then made by Henry, seconded by Huffsmith to adopt Resolution #4 approving financing by the Waverly Township Municipal Authority of Keystone College projects.

Susan Gruss addressed the Board regarding water coming across the road from Federici's property. There has been ongoing problems with water coming across the road into her property for some time. Supervisor Gerald Henry will have Penn DOT investigate.

Zoning Officer sent the second letter to Simmons and will look into the project that Federici is working on for the last two weeks. Motion to adjourn by Henry, seconded by Wohlken.
